Short Term plans:

- Conduct two training programs/FDPs/EDPs/ Workshops / Lectures / Seminars/e-Talk etc per year for skill and competency development.
- Organize two competition events like campus Hackathon and Boot-camps etc. per year.

Long term Plans:

- Developing a Critical Mass of Motivated Students & Faculties with Entrepreneurial Orientation & Skill.
- 50% of student & faculty mass with entrepreneurship Orientation
- 5% of Graduate students will choose Entrepreneurship as career
- 5 Established Start-ups

Key Performing Indicators:

- No. of training programs/FDPs/EDPs/ Workshops Lectures/Seminars/e- Talk etc per year for skill and competency development.
- No. of competition events like campus Hackathon and Boot-camps etc. per year.

- No. of Students to complete Entrepreneurship Education through MOOC, Class Room, and Experiential Learning programs.

This session was exceptionally informative and inspiring. At the end of this session we were asked the members and participants to give their valuable suggestions. 56 faculty members, 3 alumni students, 2 parents and all committee members have enthusiastically participated in the online session.
