#### SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### 4. Investments

Long term and short term investments are valued at cost.

#### 5. Debtors and receivables

Sundry debtors and other receivables are recognized at their realizable value.

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#### 6. Cash & Bank balance

- i. Cash balances are adopted as certified by the Trustee/Accountant.
- ii. Bank Balances are recognized as per books and reconciled with the bank statements



- 7. Unsecured loans from some Managing trustees and from outside parties are interest bearing.
- 8. All the loans, sundry creditors, and sundry debtors are subject to the reconciliation and confirmations obtained.
